Lagoon Point Community Improvement Projects

We have continued gathering information on two primary projects; repair/replacing the Lagoon Bulkhead and replacing the current keys for accessing the Boat Launch area, "Lot C" with new electronic keys.

The 2014-15 budget included an estimated cost to complete the new gate/key system. We have received more accurate pricing information and will be moving this project out to next year, due to higher costs than originally estimated. This will be reflected in the 2015-16 proposed operating budget.

We have also received concern from community members around some overgrown lots. Please do your part to keep our community beautiful and take care to not let your lots become overgrown and out of control.
