There will also be a **Special Meeting from 5-6pm**, just prior to the Annual Meeting at the same place, in response to a local petition to review the current projects underway.


All owners are encouraged to attend and participate.

# New Fishing Tags for your Car and Person

We have been distributing the new fishing and car tags. Please contact LPCA99@gmail.com if you still need to turn in you old tags and receive new ones.

REMINDER: The tags exist for two reasons. First, to identify LPCA members while fishing on the community's private beach areas. Second, to easily identify yourself to your neighbors that have permitted you to fish on their private beach areas.

Everyone receives 2 fishing tags and one car tag for your trailer towing vehicles while parked on Lot C. You are supposed to accompany your guests when using the tags. You do not need a tag for every person if you are fishing with a group of people on the beach, rather you should be with your group.

### 2015 Lagoon Point Fishing Derby

#### **2015 Crabbing Season Underway**

### Reminder: crab pots MUST NOT be placed in the navigable areas of the canals.

It is a state law that the lines used must be either sinking type, or at least weighted so they don't trail over the water's surface to be a hazard to navigation or get tangled in a propeller.

Please be respectful of the considerable boat traffic going in and out of the canals and keep your lines tied off so the floats don't drift into the middle of the canal and drop crab pots in east end of the lagoon around the area near the bridge.

#### **Lot C Gate Update**

The new Lot C Gate is scheduled for installation at the end of July/ beginning of August.

The installation will begin with posts being set the last week of July. The old keys will remain in effect through this process.

The Gate is scheduled for installation the a.m. of August 4th. There will not be any interruption to people's use of the boat launch before, during or after the project.

New key cards will be distributed during the week of August 3. A specific email notification with information on key distribution will be sent the week of July 27.
