

### **STORMS & KING TIDES:**

The winter storm season began in earnest on November 4<sup>th</sup> with a wind from the west measuring as high as 70 mph on our weather station before the power went out. Viewing the damage to the power lines on Smugglers Cove Road the next morning let us know it would be out for more than a day or two. The storm also resulted in loss of material on the beachfronts. The beach level went down far enough to expose the DNR markers at the North County beach access. It makes you wonder if the beach was that low when the markers were installed or if they excavated to install the posts years ago.





The King Tides of December 27<sup>th</sup> combined with low barometric pressure caused higher water levels than Lagoon Point had experienced before. The connection point of the boat launch dock was under water as was a good part of Shell Street. The picture under the newsletter heading on Page 1 shows that the high tide was even with Seashore Ave. Some member homes experienced water damage inside their residences

### **LPCA Website – Members Area Password**

To access the Members Area of the Lagoon Point website you must have a password. The following are the instructions on how to receive your password:

- Start on the Lagoon Point Members page by clicking on Private Information tab.
- A dialogue box will pop up on your screen. Click on "Register" in the lower left corner.
- The next dialogue box pops up titled "Register for this site" where you enter all your own information. You choose your own sign on name and your own personal password. You will be asked for your Lagoon Point address here on the island, not a mailing address somewhere else. Save your information somewhere safe.

Once you register for the Members Area, our web site server will notify us of a pending new member for verification. Once LPCA is notified of your registration, we can grant you access to LPCA private access. We don't set up your private info, you do.
