For those who are new and and to remind the rest of us... the speed limit within the Lagoon Point neighborhood is 20 mph. It may seem slow, but the summer brings us all outside to walk with our families and dogs. Let's keep the street safe for everyone. I recently returned from a vacation trip to Tofino with friends from the neighborhood. We witnessed a wildfire (a little too close) that has affected many on Vancouver Island by cutting off their main travel route indefinitely. Isolating communities with few options for travel in and out. As we get into summer with dry weather and the July 4 festivities it is a good idea to review the defensible space around our homes. Please mow your vacant lots and remove all combustible materials.

Boaters should also note the extent of the bar that is continuing to develop at the east end of the jetty channel. The deepest part of the channel at this location is nearer the north side. Go down at a low tide to make sure you know the waterway and don't find the bottom by accident. The waterway committee has been reviewing proposals to determine the best path to move forward with the environmental and permitting phase of the shoreline and bulkhead restoration project combined with the maintenance dredge of the siltation basin. We are trying to use the lessons learned from the past dredging projects to avoid unnecessary project studies or tasks. More information will be forthcoming as the process moves forward.

LPCA Website – Members Area Password

To access the Members Area of the Lagoon Point website you must have a password. The following are the instructions on how to receive your password:

- Start on the Lagoon Point Members page by clicking on Private Information tab.
- A dialogue box will pop up on your screen. Click on "Register" in the lower left corner.
- The next dialogue box pops up titled "Register for this site" where you enter all your own information. You choose your own sign on name and your own personal password. You will be asked for your Lagoon Point address here on the island, not a mailing address somewhere else. Save your information somewhere safe.

Once you register for the Members Area, our web site server will notify us of a pending new member for verification. Once LPCA is notified of your registration, we can grant you access to LPCA private access. We don't set up your private info, you do.
